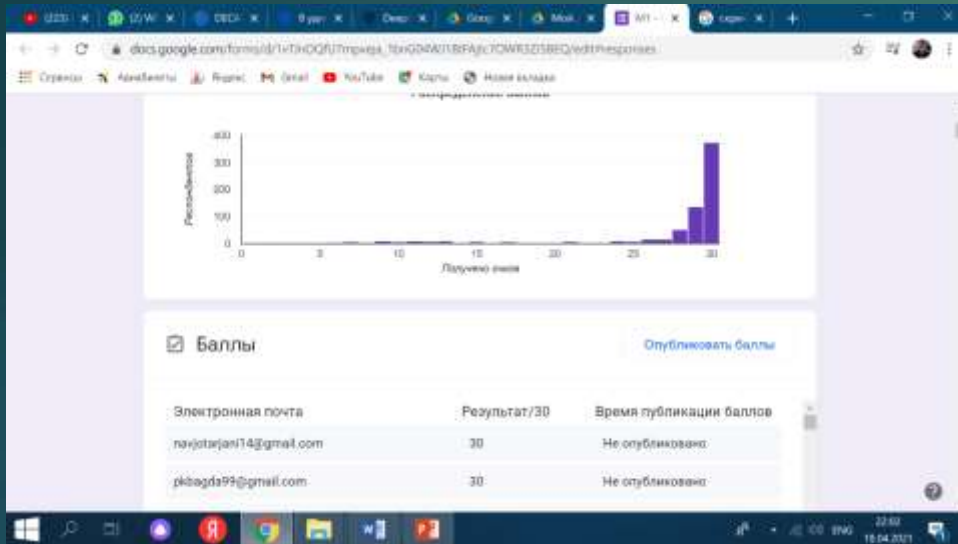

- ▶ 5. Secure data storage (Безопасное хранение данных.)

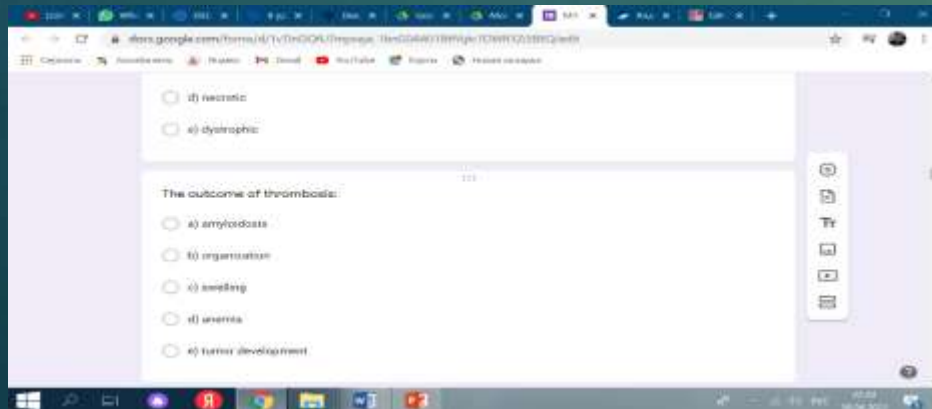
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- ▶ 6. Scalability(Масштабируемость)

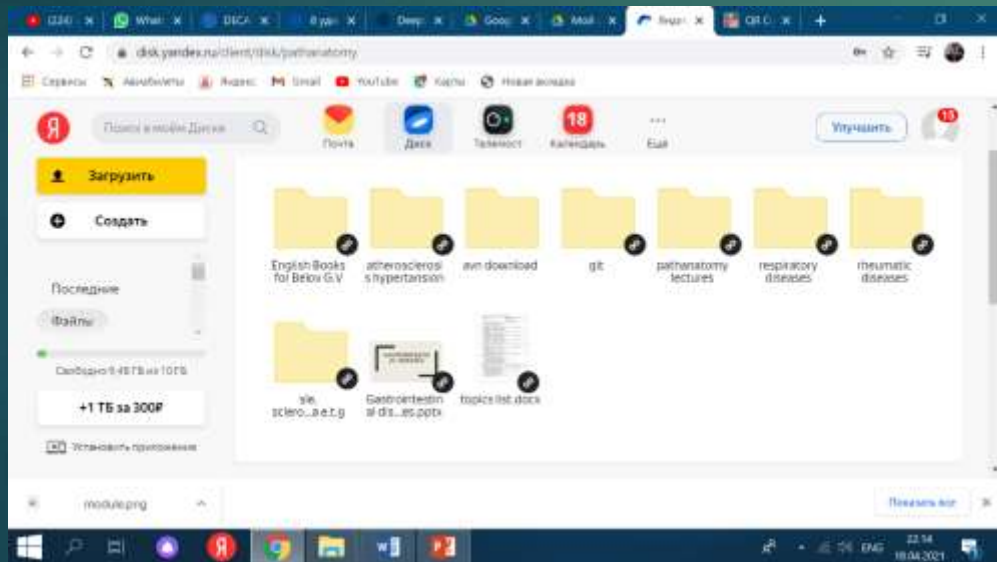

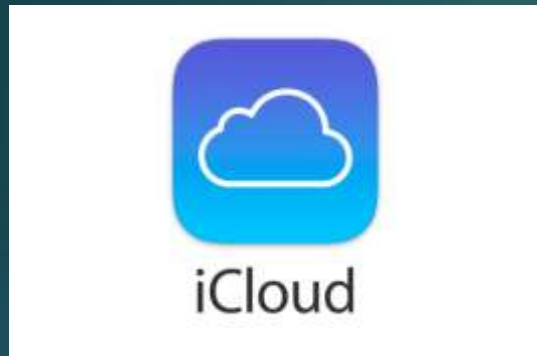
