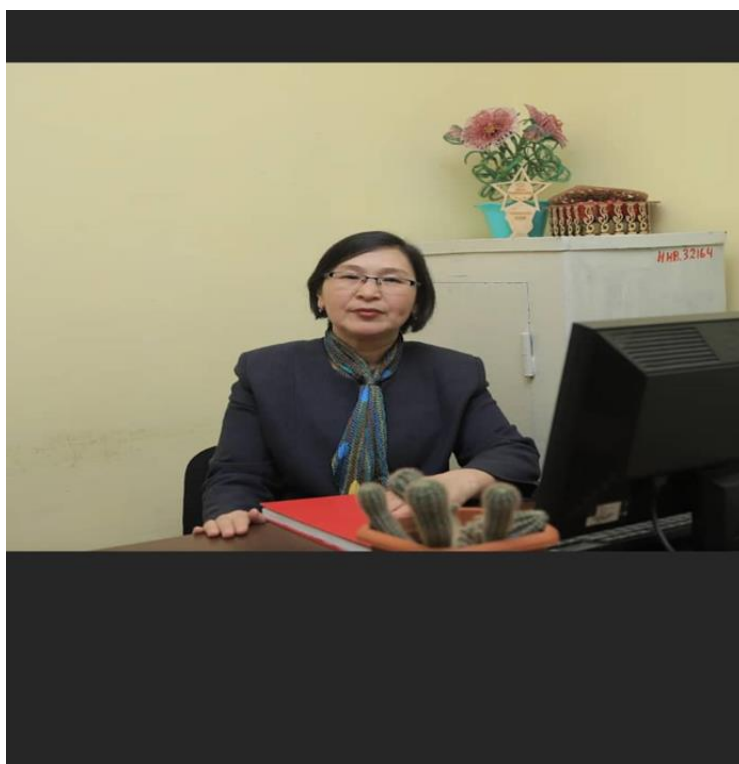


The history of the Department of the English language Phonetics and Grammar

The history of the Department of the English Language Phonetics and Grammar begins back in 1952. Thanks to the efforts of the experienced teaching staff like Kovalchuk V., Anarbayev A., Nigmatullina G., Akhunzhanov M. and Kadyrov K.P. today the department is one of the leading and promising departments of the Faculty of World Languages and Cultures of Osh State University. By the decree of the Rector of Osh State University in 2010, the department was renamed as the Department of the English Language Phonetics and Grammar.

From 2005-2023, Associate Professor of the Department, PhD in Philology, Akmatova A.A. headed the Department with high performance in the field of science, education and educational activities of Osh State University.

Currently, Associate professor of the department, Turgunbaeva Baktygul Jeenmyrzaevna is the head of this chair. The department employs 35 highly qualified teachers, including 5 candidates of Sciences, 1 PhD in Philology, 7 associate professors, 12 senior and 16 teachers and 1 methodologist.
