SPHIGMOMANOMETER

4. Mercury Manometer:

It is the main element that displays blood pressure readings. It consists of a vertical glass tube filled with mercury. As pressure increases in the cuff, it causes the mercury column to rise. The height of the mercury column, measured in millimeters of mercury (mmHg), corresponds to the pressure exerted on the cuff.

5.Scale and Calibration: The scale on the mercury manometer is calibrated to measure blood pressure in millimeters of mercury. Calibration ensures the accuracy of the instrument.





STATISTICAL ANALYSIS

Characteristics of the study population: A total of 100 college students aged \geq 18years were screened for hypertension.

of the students 50 were males and 50 were females. About 17% had a family history of chronic diseases.

6% of the students were overweight.

Smoking, insufficient sleep, academic stress and alcohol consumption:

6% of the students reported smoking cigarettes, of whom

1 (50%) was a daily smoker. About 32% reported not getting enough sleep and 22% of them suffer from academic stress.

About 17% of the students consumed alcohol daily. The mean (#SD) sleep duration for the students was 5 hrs.



STATISTICAL ANALYSIS

Physical activity level:


About 20% (24% of the males and 11% of the females) were classified as having a high (vigorous) physical activity level. Only 15% had a moderate physical activity level, and the rest 65% had a low physical activity level.

Blood pressure:

A total of 8 (8%) students were hypertensive. About 36% and 55% had pre-hypertensive and normal blood pressure, respectively. The rest 2% had hypertensive blood pressure.




blood pressure in male and female















blood pressure in students
