Conference Organizer: Institute of Philology and Intercultural Communication, Osh State University.

Date: May 16, 2025 (beginning at 10:00 AM, Kyrgyzstan time).

Venue: Institute of Philology and Intercultural Communication, Osh State University. (Kyrgyzstan, Osh, Lenin Street, 331 (Electronic library of Osh SU), Room 309).

Format: Dialogue and discussion platforms will be organized both offline and online via the Zoom platform.

Conference Participants: Scientists, scientific supervisors, Ph.D. students, and master's students.

Conference Language: English, Kyrgyz and Russian languages

Presentation Format: 5-7-minute presentation with a multimedia presentation, 2-minute discussion.

Conference Goals:

- To promote clear and effective communication in scientific research across disciplines.
- To enhance researchers' ability to present their findings in a way that reaches a broader audience;
- To provide a platform for exchanging best practices in writing, presenting, and disseminating scientific knowledge;
- To foster critical thinking and analytical skills for improving the clarity and impact of research publications.

Conference Objectives:

- To equip participants with practical strategies for producing clear, impactful, and widely accessible scientific writing across various academic disciplines;
- To expand the reach of research by exploring methods to increase the accessibility, visibility, and influence of scientific findings across diverse audiences and platforms;
- To enhance scientific communication skills by providing opportunities for participants to improve their academic writing, public speaking, and research presentation abilities;
- To facilitate interdisciplinary collaboration by encouraging cooperation among researchers from different fields to improve the clarity, relevance, and dissemination of scientific knowledge;
- To promote active research engagement by motivating students to participate in scientific inquiry and emphasizing the importance of clear, meaningful, and audience-oriented communication.

Conference Direction: Philology, Humanities, Linguistics

- Clarity in scientific discourse: Exploring linguistic and stylistic strategies for enhancing the clarity of academic and scientific writing;
- **Effective science communication:** The role of language in making research accessible to diverse audiences, including non-specialists;
- Overcoming linguistic barriers in research dissemination: Strategies for translating and adapting scientific findings for international and interdisciplinary collaboration;
- The role of terminology in scientific precision: Analyzing the impact of terminology choices on the clarity and interpretation of research;
- **Interdisciplinary communication in science:** Examining how linguistic and cultural factors influence the understanding and sharing of scientific knowledge across disciplines.

Expected Results:

- Improved clarity in scientific writing and communication: Participants will gain insights into structuring and presenting research findings more effectively;
- Enhanced accessibility of scientific research: Strategies will be developed for making research more understandable and widely accessible to both academic and non-academic audiences:
- **Strengthened interdisciplinary collaboration:** Researchers from different fields will exchange ideas and best practices, fostering cooperation in scientific communication;
- **Development of scientific communication skills:** Participants will improve their ability to write, present, and disseminate research findings clearly and persuasively;
- **Increased engagement in research dissemination:** The conference will motivate researchers to actively share their work through publications, presentations, and digital platforms.

Event Format:

- Oral presentations: Presentation of research results.
- Round tables: Participation in discussions on current issues.

All participants who give an oral presentation will receive certificates, and the best scientific works of the participants will be awarded diplomas of I, II, and III degrees.
