Lesson Plan: First Conditional Teacher: Tashmamatova A. **Duration:** 90 minutes Topic: First Conditional

Main aim: Students will be able to form and use the First Conditional to talk about real or

possible situations in the future.

Learning outcomes / Results (PO1, OK1, IIK1, IIK4)

By the end of the lesson students will be able to: use the First Conditional to express real future situations; form conditional sentences using If + Present Simple, will + verb; participate in dialogues and short speaking activities using the structure correctly; demonstrate understanding of grammar rules through written and oral exercises.

Stage	Time	Activities	Interaction	Aims
1. Warm-up	10 min	Teacher asks: What will you do if it rains tomorrow? Students answer freely. Short discussion about possible future situations.	Whole class	To activate background knowledge and introduce topic context.
2. Presentation	15 min	Teacher explains structure: If + Present Simple, will + Verb. Examples on board: If I study hard, I will pass the exam. / If it rains, we will stay at home. Elicit rule and highlight comma use.	T-Ss	To present grammar structure and meaning.
3. Controlled practice	20 min	Worksheet: students complete sentences, choose correct verb forms, and match clauses. Example: If I (go) to the party, I (see) my friends.	Pair work	To practice form and meaning in written form.
4. Listening activity	10 min	Listen to short dialogue (e.g., about travel plans). Students identify First Conditional sentences and write them down.	Individual	To improve listening comprehension and identify grammar in context.
5. Speaking practice	20 min	"Chain game": One student says a sentence: If I have time, I will go shopping. Next continues: If I go shopping, I will buy new shoes, etc. Then pairs make mini-dialogues about weekend plans.	Pair / group	To use grammar in spoken interaction.
6. Writing activity	10 min	Students write 3 sentences about their own life using First Conditional (e.g., <i>If I finish my</i>	Individual	To reinforce grammar in written form.
