Research Method: Online survey (monitoring is carried out through the collection, processing, and analysis of information).


The survey was conducted via Google Form.

Period of Conducting: November 2025.


Students of the 4th year participated in the survey.

Overall satisfaction with the teaching quality in Hospital Therapy




How well were the topics explained during lectures and practicals?


Which topics did you find most difficult?


Which teaching methods helped you learn best?


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Preferred method of assessment









5. Aspects students wish to improve:

- · More clinical cases related to real patients
- Slower and clearer explanations of complex diagnostic algorithms
- More visuals (ECG strips, X-ray/CT examples, lab panels)
- Additional practice on differential diagnosis and treatment protocols

Strengths and Positive Feedback

• High student interest in Hospital Therapy as a clinical discipline.

- Many students reported that lessons were "highly interactive" and teachers effectively linked theory to clinical practice.
- · Active use of modern teaching tools: CBD, PBL, quizzes, demonstrations, and multimedia resources.
- Multiple positive comments about teachers: "explains clearly", "supports students", "very interactive", "makes clinical topics easy to understand".

Areas Needing Improvement

• A small portion of students reported only "moderate" interactivity during classes.

• Some requested more real-life clinical examples, more diagnostic guidance, and algorithm-based teaching.

• A minority rated their experience lower due to fast lecture pace or difficulty understanding diagnostic/treatment protocols.

• Topics like cardiology, gastroenterology, respiratory therapy, and endocrinology were frequently marked as challenging, indicating the need for reinforcement.

RESOLUTIONS

1. Increase interactivity during sessions.

Introduce short group discussions, peer-to-peer teaching, and dedicated Q&A blocks after lectures.

2. Strengthen support for complex clinical topics.

Provide additional review sessions, algorithm charts, diagnostic flowcharts, ECG/X-ray interpretation guides.

3. Expand clinical case integration.

Include more patient scenarios in lectures, practical sessions, and assessments to connect mechanisms with real decision-making.

4. Adjust pace and explanation depth.

Use short recaps during lectures; simplify core concepts before presenting complex diagnostics; incorporate quick formative quizzes.

5. Diversify learning materials.

Prepare curated lists of useful videos, clinical images, ECG libraries, radiology examples; encourage structured peer-group study sessions.

6. Conduct periodic feedback checks.

Mid-term surveys will help monitor the effectiveness of the implemented improvements.

Summary

Overall student feedback for Hospital Therapy is strongly positive. Students appreciate the interactive teaching style and clinical relevance. Key improvement areas include reinforcing difficult clinical topics, ensuring consistently high interactivity, and integrating more case-based and visual learning materials.
