

REGULATION on the Scholarship of the Academic Council of Osh State University (OshSU)

1. General Provisions The Scholarship of the Academic Council of Osh State University is awarded to the winners of a competition conducted in accordance with this Regulation. The competition is held once at the end of each academic year for full-time students of OshSU.

The main purpose of the competition is to encourage students who have demonstrated activity in education, science, cultural and mass events, social and organizational work, as well as sports activities, and to provide moral and material support to talented youth and stimulate their development.

2. Objectives of the Competition

2.1. Encouraging students to actively participate in academic, social, and organizational activities; 2.2. Involving students in scientific research activities; 2.3. Identifying leading students of the university and informing the public about them.

3. Procedure for Conducting the Competition

3.1. The competition is conducted in two stages. The first stage is held at faculties and colleges. Each faculty or college may nominate no more than two candidates to the university commission by May 12.

The second stage of the competition among the candidates nominated by faculties and colleges is conducted by May 17. Students are evaluated according to two criteria: academic and scientific achievements, and extracurricular social activities. The competition results are determined by a point-based evaluation in accordance with the criteria specified in Clause 3.3.

3.2 Students who have passed the second stage must submit the following documents to Office No. 121 of the main building of OshSU by May 15: – Application expressing the student's desire to participate in the competition; – Certificate of accumulated semester grades (transcript); – Student portfolio confirming achievements (copies of documents and photographs must be included); – Motivational essay of up to 300 words answering the question: "Why do I deserve this scholarship?"; – Recommendation from the Dean or Director.

4. Financial Support and Awarding

4.1. Financial support for the competition is provided from the internal budget of OshSU.

4.2. The total prize fund of the competition is determined annually by the Economic Planning Department and the Supervisory Board.

4.3. Winners are awarded a one-time scholarship of the Academic Council of OshSU and a certificate.

5. Organizing Group and Its Responsibilities

5.1. The first stage of the competition is organized by deputy deans for student affairs at faculties and colleges together with student councils, and materials are submitted to the university commission.

5.2. The organizing group arranges and conducts the award ceremony for the winners.

6. Composition of the Commission

6.1. The organization and conduct of the first stage are carried out by a commission approved by order of the head of the relevant structural unit. The commission includes representatives responsible for educational and scientific work, heads of trade union bureaus, curators, teachers, women's councils, student councils, and the student ombudsman's office.

6.2. The organization and conduct of the second stage are carried out by a commission approved by order of the Rector. The commission includes representatives of vice-rectors, trade unions, women's councils, sports clubs, student councils, and the ombudsman's office.

6.3. The work of the commission is documented by official minutes, and its decisions are final and not subject to appeal.

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3.3. Competition participants are evaluated according to the following indicators:
