1.	Preparation	Use a sterile needle with suitable thread.	<input type="checkbox"/>
		Put on gloves	<input type="checkbox"/>
		Make sure the edges of the wound are aligned	<input type="checkbox"/>

2	Basic Surgical Knot (Double) – for starting the suture	Make the first turn of the thread around the tweezers or fingers	<input type="checkbox"/>
		The second turn is tied in the opposite direction (cross)	<input type="checkbox"/>
		Tighten the knot carefully without damaging the fabric.	
3	Intermittent knot	Tie the first knot, then cut the thread, leaving a short tail	<input type="checkbox"/>
		Tie each subsequent knot separately on a new section of the wound.	<input type="checkbox"/>
4	Mattress knot (for firmly closing tense tissue)	Insert the needle parallel to the edges of the wound	<input type="checkbox"/>
		Make a horizontal or vertical turn	<input type="checkbox"/>
		Tie a knot on the surface of the fabric without damaging the edges	<input type="checkbox"/>
5	Reliability control	Check each node for tightness and reliability	<input type="checkbox"/>
		Make sure that the tissue is not compressed (no ischemia)	<input type="checkbox"/>
		Trim off excess thread ends	<input type="checkbox"/>
		Treat the seam with an antiseptic	<input type="checkbox"/>
