1. Course characteristics:

Brief description of the discipline:

'Professional English' covers a wide range of medical vocabulary, namely: diseases and symptoms, research, treatment, examination and prevention. It also presents general medical vocabulary related to body parts and functions, medical personnel, education and training, research and presentations. The textbook was published using the medical corpus of the Institute of Applied Language Studies and is essential for teachers of medical English and practising doctors who need to use English at work both in their own country and abroad.

2. Course objective:

The main objective of the Professional English course is to develop foreign language communication skills, reading and translation skills in professional texts based on mastery of specific lexical and grammatical material, and oral communication skills on professional topics, as well as in scientific activities.

The following tasks are set to achieve this goal:

- to develop the speech, language and foreign language communication skills necessary and sufficient for the use of English in professional activities;
- to develop the skills of reading and translating professional texts in English;
- master the terminology of professional English;
- develop communication skills on professional topics.
