

**REVIEW**  
**of the Educational Standard of Higher Professional Education**  
**in the field of “Nutrition” (Master’s degree)**  
**of Osh State University**

This review has been prepared based on the analysis of the educational standard of higher professional education in the field of “Nutrition” (qualification — Master), developed at Osh State University.

The analysis established that the educational standard has been developed in accordance with the legislation of the Kyrgyz Republic in the field of education, the National Qualifications Framework, the regulatory legal acts of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Kyrgyz Republic, and the current requirements for higher professional education standards.

The structure of the educational standard is logical and includes all mandatory sections предусмотренные нормативными документами: general provisions, scope of application, characteristics of graduates’ professional activities, requirements for learning outcomes, conditions for program implementation, requirements for staffing, educational-methodological, informational and material-technical support, as well as procedures for practical training and final state certification.

The content of the educational standard is aimed at training qualified master’s graduates in nutrition who are capable of performing professional, research, preventive, organizational-managerial, and pedagogical activities. The formulated universal and professional competencies correspond to the declared types of professional activity and to the current needs of the healthcare and public nutrition systems.

The normative duration of the educational program, academic workload, and ECTS credit requirements are justified and comply with credit-based learning technology standards. The curriculum includes both mandatory and elective disciplines, various types of practice, and final state certification, ensuring the integrity and practical orientation of the educational program.

Requirements for staffing, the qualification level of academic personnel, educational-methodological, informational, and material-technical resources comply with licensing requirements and ensure the possibility of high-quality implementation of the program.

**Conclusion**

The educational standard of higher professional education in the field of “Nutrition” (Master’s degree) complies with current regulatory and licensing requirements and is recommended for approval and implementation.

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
